We are glad you have come to our church and we hope you enjoy the worship experience. Our loving and caring nursery workers are happy your child has come to take part in a fun-filled and safe environment here at **Broadman**.

Please sign-in at the counter before presenting your child to one of our nursery workers. Please ensure there is a **CHILD INFORMATION SHEET** on file at the desk. If your child has any **food allergies**, please tell one of the volunteers and make a notation on the sign-in sheet.

So we may provide a safe, nurturing environment for your child, please follow the guidelines here.

1. Only ministerial staff, nursery volunteers, children, Life Impact Group leaders and Children's Church volunteers are permitted beyond the white nursery gate without permission. Please discourage older siblings from entering the area.

2. All of the child's belongings must be clearly marked with his/her name – diaper bags, *sippie* cups, baby food jars, etc.

3. Children should be picked up by their parents/guardians promptly following all worship services.

4. Children in the toddler room are not permitted to bring any toys or personal belongings from home. Doing so distracts from regular classroom activities and the items may carry harmful germs.

5. Occasionally snacks may be served during Children's Church. Please ensure you notify us if your child has food allergies or if you do not want food served to your child.

6. Any child exhibiting symptoms of contagious diseases or illnesses may not participate in program activities. Please practice *GOOD HEALTH GUIDELINES* and keep your child at home when you observe any of the following. Our caregivers follow the same *GUIDELINES*.

FEVER/VOMITING

DIARRHEA

DISCHARGE IN / AROUND THE EYES

QUESTIONABLE RASH

GREEN OR YELLOW RUNNY-NOSE

EXCESSIVE COUGHING

ANY COMMUNICABLE DISEASE

UNCOVERED WOUNDS OR LESIONS

7. You will be promptly notified if your child becomes ill while in the nursery. If your child is being treated with an antibiotic, he/she should have received treatment for at least 24 hours before coming into the Nursery.
