RECIPE OF THE MONTH...

Cherry Pie Ice Cream



Strain hot cream onto egg yolk mixture, whisking constantly.

Return to saucepan and cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until it coats the spoon.

Strain; add almond extract and cherries.

Cool completely in refrigerator; freeze in ice cream machine according to manufacturer’s directions.

Fold in graham crackers.

Freeze until firm.

INGREDIENTS

- 3 cups heavy cream
- 1 cup milk
- 5 egg yolks
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 pinch salt
- 1/4 teaspoon almond extract
- 1 (16 ounce) jar maraschino cherries, drained and chopped
- 1 1/2 cups cinnamon graham crackers, broken into 1-inch pieces

DIRECTIONS

Heat cream and milk to just below the boil.

Whisk egg yolks, sugar, and a pinch of salt until just blended.

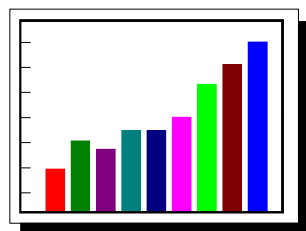

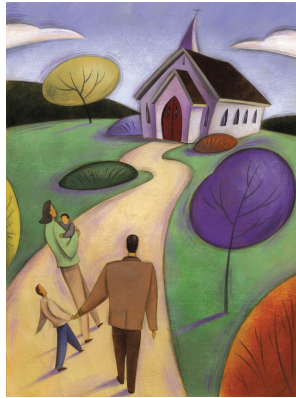

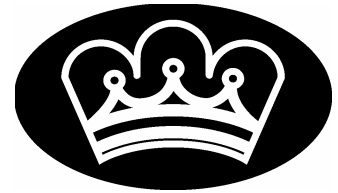

BE ON MISSION FOR GOD!

SALT & LIGHT....



“May God shed His grace on thee” are words I believe have applied to America all of my life. I grew up with great optimism about the future of America. After all, I am from the Cold War generation in which America defeated the evil empire of the U.S.S.R. The 80’s where my most impressionable years in which I found Christ, formed my beliefs about our nation and even enlisted in the Armed Services. I believed then and still do, that God blessed America because of our declaration of independence from tyranny, promotion of freedom for all peoples and our dependence upon God. But can God continue to bless us if we have removed the reasons for His blessings?

That is why it is sad for me to say that my optimism for America is not what it was in my teen years. Call me pessimistic or a realist, but the truth is our nation is in serious trouble and our moral decay is on a steep slope. We need God’s help, but most in America don’t even realize it, even professing Christians. We need to cry out to God and repent before we can ask for His blessings to continue upon our nation. Instead of God bless America we need to say God break our hearts so we can once again be the nation God blesses.

In case you don’t agree

with me let me illustrate a few examples about decisions our nation has made morally, politically and socially that have led us to today.

First, consider the judicial decisions of the Massachusetts and California Supreme Courts who have both legalized homosexual or same sex marriages. Just in case you think that is okay please read the following passage of Scripture - Romans 1:24-32. Clearly in this passage God is displeased with those who disregard God’s truth and those who practice sexual immorality through homosexuality. Think about it, our nation (that is us) has allowed men and women in black robes to dictate the morality of our nation and has allowed these high courts to defy God’s Word...they have “defied God’s truth for a lie” (Romans 1:25). Beyond the homosexual issue is the fact that the U.S. Supreme Court has disallowed prayer in our schools and disallows the teaching of God as the Creator in our schools and education system. Our U.S. Supreme Court has allowed the legalization of murder, by allowing babies to be killed in the womb and calling it ‘choice.’ How has this happened you might ask? This has all been done by judges in black robes appointed by the Executive Branch of our government. If you do not think this upcoming presidential election is important based on this reason alone you are gravely mistaken. In my opinion this is the most important presidential deciding factor. The next president will appoint future justices that will either continue the downward moral spiral or be able to stop it and reverse some of the moral damage. In the mean time we

need to pray for the U.S. Supreme Court and we must repent and ask for forgiveness for what has taken place in our moral, social and political history in these regards. We must pray that the next President and future Supreme Court Justices will not “defy God’s truth for a lie.”

Second, consider the state of Colorado which is offering restrooms for men and women and for those who are going through sexual orientation issues. Make sure you understand what this means, in Colorado you now can go to the restroom based on your sexual inclination or so called orientation. So if a man thinks he is a she he can go to the women’s restroom and vice versa for women who believes they are a he. A person’s self proclaimed identity now determines which restroom a person uses, not how God created them. Is our nation messed up or what? This is absurd and contrary to God’s Word, in fact it “defies God’s truth for a lie.”

Third, consider the restaurant chain of McDonald’s. Mickey D’s as it is called is truly an American icon for most of us. If fact, most of our children and grandchildren have grown up thinking McDonald’s is as American as you can get. However, do they share the same American values that made our Nation great? Do they currently share the values of the majority of American’s? I would argue they no longer hold to the “All American” values that most of us believe in and that founded our great nation. You may say how can Pastor Chris attack McDonald’s? How does McDonald’s have anything to do with the Bible? Before you

say that my claims are not biblical or not patriotic consider what McDonald’s has recently done. McDonald’s is now a “corporate partner” of the National Gay and Lesbian Chamber of Commerce. I hope you now understand why McDonald’s is not on my Christmas card list. I don’t know about you, but if I have a choice I will choose to patron another restaurant for my moral and perhaps even my physical health. I encourage you to do the same.

Keep in mind that I have only addressed one area of our culture that as been tainted morally, politically and socially. I have not covered all the aspects of the moral, political and social injustices, in fact I haven’t even scratched the surface. I hope you are asking how have we gotten here? If you are I have one simple answer: Can anyone say sin!!! Can anyone say that America has chosen to “defy God’s truth for a lie.” The truth is that we have become our own god. Reread Romans chapter one again and look at it in light of what I have written, American has become the Romans One nation. We have bowed our knees to someone other than the “Creator” who gives us our inalienable rights - “life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.” If we are to recover we have to return to the giver of our rights, not the rights themselves. Our focus must be on the Creator. We must stop “defying God’s truth for a lie.” This will not be easy. Things have gotten so far

out of touch with the reality of God’s truth that I am not sure what to suggest. It must start with prayer and involvement. Please stand for God’s truths in your personal lives, homes, work places, social events, and political positions. Perhaps then we can reverse the Romans 1 statement of they “defy God’s truth for a lie” and make it we defy the lie for God’s truth.

May God bless America...no...may God break America and may He then shed His Grace on thee as we return to His Truth. Go be the Salt and Light of God to our nation!!!

ble to get an exact count because the surf was good and there were just too many that couldn’t sit still long enough to tally! That’s a good problem to have!

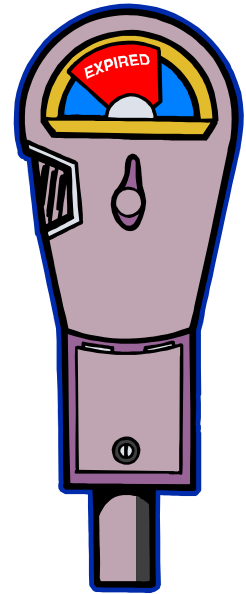

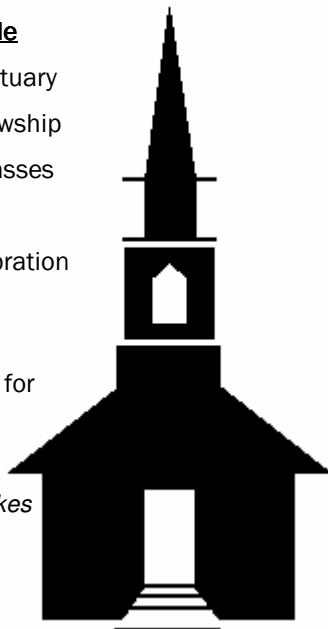
