RECIPE OF THE MONTH...

POT ROAST CARIBE

INGREDIENTS

- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1 (3 pound) boneless beef chuck roast
- 2 cloves garlic, crushed
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 (8 ounce) cans tomato sauce
- 2 tablespoons white sugar
- 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1 teaspoon chili powder
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon ground coriander
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon grated orange zest
- 2 large potatoes, cut into large chunks
- 3 carrots, sliced

- 1 stalk celery, chopped
- 1/2 cup sliced almonds

DIRECTIONS

Heat the oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat. Place the roast into the hot oil and cook, turning frequently, until browned on all sides. Remove from the skillet and place in a slow cooker.

Cook garlic and onions in the skillet in the meat drippings until tender. Stir in the salt and tomato sauce. Combine the sugar, flour, cocoa powder, chili powder, oregano, cumin, coriander, cinnamon, and orange zest; stir into the tomato sauce. Pour the tomato sauce over the roast in the slow cooker. Add potatoes, carrots and celery. Cover, and cook on Low for 6 to 8 hours, or until meat is tender. Garnish with sliced almonds before serving.

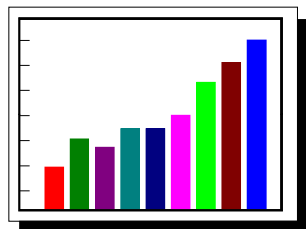

FINANCIAL PEACE TIPS...

Notes from the Dave Ramsey Financial Peace Coordinator:



Spring means new-beginnings, what a great time of the year, and with tax returns and stimulus \$'s on the way, it's a perfect time to begin a-new with your finances!

A few months ago I shared **Baby Step # 1 = \$1000 in savings**, the importance of this first step and some ways to achieve this initial step to Financial Peace.

Below is the outline of **Baby Step # 2: The Debt Snowball**, from Dave Ramsey:

Baby Step 2: The Debt Snowball

The math seems to lean more toward paying the highest interest debts first, but what I have learned is that personal finance is 20% head knowledge and **80% behavior**. The principle is to stop everything except minimum payments and focus on one thing at a time. Otherwise, nothing gets accomplished because all your effort is diluted.

You need some **quick wins** in order to stay pumped enough to get out of debt completely. When you start knocking off the easier debts, you will start to **see results** and you will **start to win** in debt reduction.

So list your debts in order with the smallest payoff or balance first (excluding the house). Do not be concerned with interest rates or terms unless two debts have similar pay-offs, then list the higher interest rate debt first.

TAKE ACTION, take the second step to Financial Freedom!

CHILDREN IN ACTION FOR BROADMAN KIDS (BK)...

Broadman is offering something special for kids in grades K – 5 called Children in Action (CIA). I want to encourage every kid to become a CIA agent for Jesus. Every kid will be placed on mission for God called “Mission Possible.” Matthew 19:26 “With God all things are possible.”

CIA starts this June (June 4) on Wednesday nights and will go through the last Wednesday of October where we will celebrate with a CIA recognition banquet. It is important that the kids get on mission from the very beginning. Your kids won't want to miss this awesome discipleship process. As kids become CIA agents for Jesus they will have opportunities to earn badges and pins for a variety of things.

What Is Children in Action?

Children in ActionSM is a discipleship program offered to our boys and girls in grades K-5 at Broadman. This discipleship program includes praying for missions, engaging in missions, learning about missions, living a mission lifestyle, participating in the mission work of the church and denomination. CIA develops our kids into CIA agents for Jesus as they go on mission for Him.

What will the kids do in Children in Action?

The kids will go through the CIA Academy held every Wednesday evening at 6:30 p.m. June through October. There CIA training will consist of the following:

Mission Notebook

Throughout the year every CIA Agent will have a mission notebook. This notebook will help every child keep up with their mission tasks. This notebook will include worksheets, pictures, Live Action Projects, notes/letters, special assignment investigative reports and secret reading assignments. Additionally there will be the Action Motto, Pledge, and Scripture. Completing these books is part of earning the coveted “2008” Chevron and graduating from the 2008 CIA Academy

Special Assignments

Special Assignments is an individualized achievement plan where kids earn special assignment badges and pins. These assignments have to be done outside of the normal Wednesday evening activities.

Earn CIA Mission Badges

Badges are a great way to recognize, encourage, reward, and motivate our Children in Action. This year we will be earning the following badges: “CIA” badge for every kid who attends at least one month straight and has 2/3 attendance, “Mission Possible” badge for every kid who memorizes the two scriptures verses and motto, the “2008” Chevron for everyone who successfully completes the program, and other special assignment badge opportunities “

Secret Reading Assignments

The purpose of "Explore God's World" Reading Club for Children is to assist children to explore God's world through books about missions, missionaries, people groups and cultures; and to help children live out the Christian faith through word and deed. The secret reading assignments will be offered throughout the summer for anyone who wants to earn the “Reading” badge.

Parental Responsibilities Commit to bringing your kids to the CIA meetings every Wednesday at 6:30, help your kids be involved in the special assignments, encourage you kids to earn CIA badges, help your child fill out the Mission Notebook weekly and participate in the recognition banquet at the end of the CIA semester. Beyond your commitment we are also asking for each parent to give a suggested \$25 donation to the church to help cover the costs of sashes, badges, and curriculum. This is not required but encouraged. If you would like to do this make your check out to Broadman Baptist Church (CIA).

CIA AGENT TRAINERS NEEDED We still need CIA trainers. If you are interested in helping train these young kids to be on mission possible for God please tell Pastor Chris or Rick Mangrum.

Reading Program: Kids can participate in a reading club over the summer and earn a reading badge.

A FATHER'S INFLUENCE...

Studies show that if the mother of a family attends worship, there's a 16 percent chance that the rest of the family will also attend.

Yet when a father attends worship, there's a 93 percent chance that other family members will be present, too.

SUNDAY MORNING RUSH...

A mother, trying to get her family to church on time, came up with this poem:

It's a mad dash after waking up and opening the sash, then eating and looking for the offertory cash, then speeding to church in a flash and finally, plopping in a pew with a crash.

If you can relate to that (and who can't, at some point?), develop a Saturday-night strategy that results in less-hecked Sundays. Plan everyone's outfit to avoid last-minute changes. Make breakfast ahead of time — or keep it simple. Place Bibles, lesson plans, filled offering envelopes and any children's items by the door.

Getting to church is always worth the effort, but the process can also help enhance your worship experience. By planning ahead, you can transform the mad dash into a calm time of togetherness.

FATHER'S DAY...

The first celebration of Father's Day is thought to have been in July 1908, in Fairmont, West Virginia. Grace Golden Clayton suggested the special observance to her pastor after a deadly explosion in a nearby town killed 361 men.

Soon after, Sonora Smart Dodd of Spokane, Washington, wanted to show her gratitude to her father, who'd cared for the family after his wife died. Dodd asked her pastor to choose a June Sunday to honor all fathers, and he selected June 19, 1910.

In 1924, President Coolidge suggested that Father's Day become a national holiday. In

1966, President Johnson designated the third Sunday of June to be Father's Day. Six years later, President Nixon instituted Father's Day as a national observance.

Nevaeh is a recent invention, appearing suddenly in 1999. That year, there were eight baby Nevaehs born in the United States. The next year, there were 86. Now the name is in the top 50 most popular baby girl names. Parents select Nevaeh because it has meaning, uniqueness and star-connection.

Names during biblical times carried not just meaning but a hoped-for destiny. While the name "Jesus" was as common in that day as Michael, John or David are today, its meaning was entirely uncommon for him. Jesus literally means "salvation" or "the Lord saves."

No matter your given name, take pride in your label as a Christian. That name shows your true meaning and destiny.

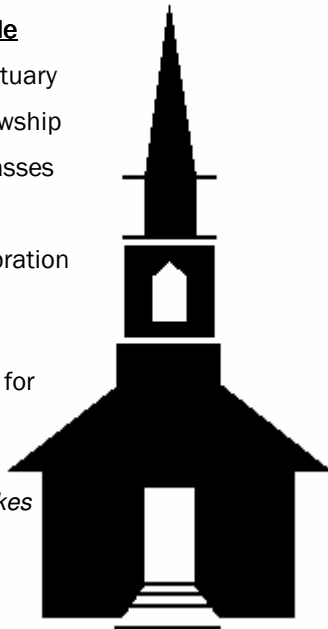
