APPLICATION

HOW DOES THE NAME OF GOD / JESUS/ HOLY SPIRIT AFFECT MY LIFE?

JOHN 14: 12-14 Jesus promised, "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do because I go to the Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask Me anything in My name, I will do it."

2. Will the thing I ask for in His name glorify the Father in the Son?
