



CHILDREN 2010 ANNUAL REPORT

This report addresses the 2011 **Children's Ministry** goals and activities.

- ▶ Provide childcare for all major church events.
- ▶ Ensure the Ministry is one in which volunteers look forward to serving.
- ▶ Handbook: Educate and utilize; involve leadership, volunteers and parents.
- ▶ Train using a ONE-TO-ONE approach instead of GROUP training.
- ▶ Provide a 52-week Extended Care Curriculum.
- ▶ Foster a TEAM concept in scheduling ministry volunteers and in the rest of the Children's Ministry.
- ▶ Complete twenty background checks.
- ▶ Establish a healthful ministry in which parents want their kids to participate.
 - Kids learn about Jesus.
 - Kids are being saved.
 - Establish a core doctrine to be taught.
 - Establish core-Bible stories/character studies.
- ▶ Enlist and be leaders of Sunday School (*Life Impact*), Kids' Worship, Children's Choir, Nursery, Toddlers and Children of Vacation Bible School. Be united in raising up Children in Jesus, the Christ.
- ▶ Ensure the Children's Ministry is a ministry, a part, in the overall ministries of Broadman. It takes a church.
- ▶ Vacation Bible School
 - Goals: 175 children, 10 decisions for Christ and 80 workers.
 - Host the Northeast VBS Training clinic for the Ohio State Convention.

▶ Children in Action (CIA)

- Conduct worship periods during Wednesday at Broadman in the summer.
- Schedule special activities in which Children earn CIA badges.
- Teach Children that they too are missionaries.



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
