The current economic situation has most certainly had an adverse impact on 2010 giving, but because of growth from new families and financial rededication by many in our congregation our financial needs have been adequately met.

Our church continues to be financially sound, and the indebtedness for our parking lot has been reduced to less than \$26,000, thanks to our congregation's generosity. Of course we look forward to the day when we are once again debt-free, realizing however that there will be future capital projects where loan arrangements will have to be made.

In early fall of 2010, our search for a collegiate minister was completed with the addition of Michael Puckett to our congregation.
