The instrumental group now prepares all music for 1 worship service each month, as well as weekly music during Christmas!! Shannon Mangrum is the leader for this group and has done a great job planning, providing music and scheduling the practices. The Instrumental group has been a blessing!!!
- ♪ New instrumental additions this year included the keyboard, which Shawnetta McCombs has had great fun learning how it works and has blessed us so much playing in the Worship Service, as well as L.C. Maull playing guitar.

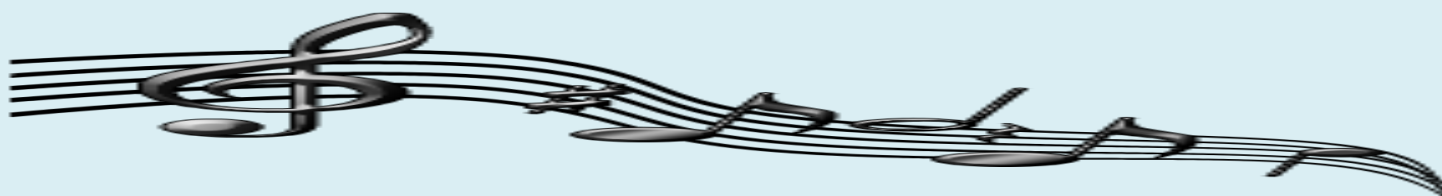

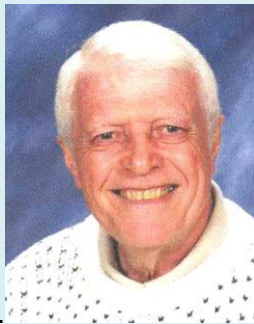
